Award of Culinary Excellence

Nomination Guidelines

Award Objective:

Recognize an outstanding Individual's commitment and dedication to high standards and to the welfare of this Association.

- Nominator must submit a written explanation on his or her reasons that they are nominating the candidate and give a definite example of why they deserve the award. *(Nominator name will be the ballot as the sponsor.)*
- Nominations must be submitted to Elections Chairperson no later than the November board meeting.
- The ACE award is chosen by the sitting Chapter President, after discussion and consultation with the Board of Directors.

Candidate Eligibility:

- Recipient of the ACE award does not have to be a Chef, but must have a connection to the industry.
- The recipient of the ACE award must have high professional standards and a concern for the welfare of this association.
- The ACE award winner should show a willingness to use the award for their own personal continuing education. Should the ACE award winner choose, in lieu of personal education, they may grant their award value back to the chapter to be used to support a local culinary program.
- Must participate in at least one function of the ACF Central Florida Chapter per calendar year or have provided services or food product in supporting the event.

Award:

A Culinarian of the Year Plaque from the Chapter
A Continuing Education Gift Certificate (\$500) *

** Payable to the educational institution for an education course or American Culinary Federation for a Regional or National Conference. Good for two years from the year awarded.*
